SCHOOL UNIFORM FOR GIRLS

School Blazer – **full buttons**

School long-sleeved jersey (bottle green)

White regulation blouses (summer)

White Short sleeve shirt with tie (winter)

School tie

Bottle green skirt – **below the knee**

White socks to be worn in the summer terms.

Black regulation tights to be worn with skirt in the winter term.

Plain brown buckle or lace up shoes

School scarves (colour and measurements to comply with school requirements)

Regulation Green School hat with school logo.

School bag with name clearly marked on the outside.

No 1's for specific assemblies/functions

School Blazer

Regulation white short sleeved shirts.

Regulation bottle green skirt with white socks in summer and black tights in winter.

6th Form can wear white long sleeved shirts.

BOARDER GIRLS

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR BOARDERS

GIRLS SPORTS WEAR AS REQUIRED	
Athletics	Yellow shirt/ dark green shorts. School Track Suit House colours shirts may be worn for practice
Basketball U14 to 2ND Team	Green shorts and Eaglesvale White golf Shirt
First Team	Design as determined by the School. First Team Tracksuit
Hockey	Green shorts and White Eaglesvale Golf Shirt. Long green socks.
First Team	Design as determined by the School. First Team Tracksuit
Squash	School Golf shirt and Green Shorts. White socks. Suitable squash sport shoes.
Swimming	School costume as stocked by official School stockist. School tracksuit Track shoes to be worn going to or from the pool or travelling. Slops may be worn in the pool area only.
Tennis	Eaglesvale golf shirts for all practices/matches (unless otherwise specified by the coach)
U14/U15/U16B Teams	Green shorts and matching pants
U16A/ 2ND Team	Green shorts and matching pants

Tennis First Team	Design as determined by the School. First Team Tracksuit
Volleyball	School Golf shirt and Green Shorts. Track shoes.
First Team	Design as determined by the School. First Team Tracksuit.

GIRLS DRESS CODE	
Shoes	Plain brown leather (dark chocolate brown) 6 th Form may wear regulation court shoes. No stiletto heels.
Ties	Worn with white buttoned up shirt.
Shirts/Blouses	Plain white regulation cotton shirt or blouse. Long sleeves for 6th form must not be rolled up Tucked in fully at all times Pointed collar and tie to be worn in winter and on Mondays and Fridays White rounded collar shirts to be worn at other times No logos or insignia on pockets Either white or flesh coloured bras to be worn, no multi colours
Tights	To be worn in winter.
Skirts	To be worn on or below the knee, NOT above or at mid-calf No rolling up of waistband Must be clean at all times
Hair	Only white, yellow or natural hair colour slides to be worn No fancy clips No thick bands i.e Alice bands or towelling band No floppy bows Hair must not be oily No dye, perming, peroxide, crimping or extensions. Hair which touches under the chin must be tied up appropriately and be tidy at all times. Fringe must be above the eyebrows No fancy hairstyles

Name Badges	To be worn at all times on outer layer of clothing on left lapel of blazer or blouse
Jewellery	Sleeper earrings or plain gold/silver studs. NO coloured stones. Earrings to be worn in the bottom pierced hold and only one earring per ear. No bracelets or chains except for Medic Alert No rings Only plain St Christopher and plain Crosses on plain chains worn on inside of shirt or blouse
Nails	Must not be seen over finger tips No coloured nail polish Must be clean and well-kept at all times No artificial nails
Socks	Must be plain white and regulation length, not rolled but folded over once or twice only. No thick, woolly socks to be worn.
Make-up	Absolutely no make-up whatsoever.
Headgear	No beanies. Hats are not to be worn indoors or in the passageways.
General	Hair must be tied up at all times. Blazer or tracksuit, as appropriate, must be worn before and after sports. Shirts must be tucked in at all times No heavy deodorants No chewing gum. All issued text books must be cared for by carrying in a strong back pack or case. No ladies handbags for carrying books.
