### **CHISZ Charter for Sport - Boys Cricket**

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS (signed on behalf of all CHISZ schools):**

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage your child and your child's team from unfair play.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Encourage your child to be a team player.
- Be supportive of all the players on the team. Cheer the team not individuals.
- Give positive feedback.
- Respect the officials (no questioning or abuse of officials, direct or indirect, during or immediately after matches); accept their decisions.
- Respect the role of the coach and refrain from coaching your child during games.
- Address or report any parent who will not abide by this Code of Conduct.
- Use correct and proper language at all times (no swearing or abusive language)
- Refrain from criticising the opposing team.
- Do not interfere with team selection, coaching or fixtures.
- No betting on school matches by parents is to be allowed.
- No alcohol to be consumed before or during school matches.

## School Fees

### **Revised Fee Schedule for Term 3, 2019**

The School Management Board in consultation with the Parents Teachers Association reviewed Term 3, 2019 fees. The fees

1. PTA LEVY : **ZWL\$180 = 20 UNITS**
  2. TUITION FOR GRADE 0 TO 7: **ZWL\$8 500 = 786 UNITS**  
i.e. Total fees paid = ZWL8 500 + PTA Levy ZWL180 = ZWL8 650  
786 units + 20 units = 806 units
  3. TUITION FOR PROGRESS CLASS: **ZWL\$9 240 = 853 UNITS**  
i.e. Total fees paid = ZWL9 240 + PTA Levy ZWL180 = ZWL9 420  
853 units + 20 units = 873 units
  4. BOARDING FEES: **ZWL\$13 200 = 1 466 UNITS**  
i.e. Total fees paid by boarders = ZWL13 200 + Tuition ZWL8 500 + PTA Levy ZWL180 = ZWL21 880  
1 466 units + 786 units + 20 units = 2 272 units
2. BUS FARE FOR THE TERM: ZWL35 per Day X 61 days = **ZWL\$2 135**

### **PAYMENTS & PAYMENT PLANS**

1. Parents and Guardians who had paid the previously communicated fees have the option to carry forward the excess payment OR request for a refund from the School.
2. A payment arrangement put in place for all Parents with non-examinations students/pupils is as follows:
  - 50% of the ZWL amount is to be paid before Schools open and this is equivalent to half the number of the Eaglesvale units. This is not subject to change until 9 September 2019.

- 25% of the Eaglesvale units is due and payable on 30 September 2019. The ZWL amount shall be determined by the prevailing interbank rate at that time.
- The last 25% of the Eaglesvale units is due and payable on 21 October 2019 (Half Term). The ZWL amount shall be determined by the prevailing interbank rate at that time.
- If fees are paid in full before Schools open, they will not be subject to top ups unless there are serious economic fundamentals that would warrant a call for a top up.
- **Fees for all examination classes must be paid in full before Schools open.**

**NB:** ACCESS CARDS SHALL BE ISSUED BASED ON MEETING ABOVE PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS ONLY.
